

## PA LICENSE TO CARRY INFORMATION

For the safety of our employees and the visiting public, the following guidelines will be followed until further notice.

Due to the Covid-19 epidemic, persons living outside of Pennsylvania will not be permitted to enter the Erie County Courthouse for the purpose of obtaining a Concealed Carry Permit at this time.

Beginning November 18th, the Erie County Sheriff's Office will again begin accepting mail in applications for concealed carry permits from persons living outside of Pennsylvania.

Non-residents will be able to mail your application to the Erie County Sheriff's Office 140 W 6th St Erie, PA 16501.

### \*\*MAIL IN APPLICATION PROCEDURE\*\*

Sign and date the application for the day you filled it out.

A fee in the amount of \$20 in the form of a MONEY ORDER must be included.

Do NOT send checks or cash.

The only form of payment accepted will be a money order.

You must include a black and white photocopy of both sides of your drivers' license. The driver's license MUST have your current address on it.

Non-residents must include a photocopy of your firearms permit from the state in which you reside.

Include a working phone number as you will be contacted by the Sheriff's Office to set up an appointment to have your picture taken and your signature captured once you are able to enter the courthouse.

Governor Wolf has granted an extension to license to carry firearms permits that have expired after March 19, 2020, making them valid until December 31, 2020. Further extensions are expected.
