Erie County reports 167 new positive cases of COVID-19; cumulative total is 3,630

Erie, PA – County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper and Erie County Department of Health announce 167 new positive cases of COVID-19 and four new deaths have been reported in Erie County as of 11:59 p.m. on Nov. 16.

The total cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Erie County is 3,630, with 2,457 recovered cases, 1,110 active cases and 63 deaths (reported in NEDSS).
