Erie County reports 106 new positive cases of COVID-19; cumulative total is 4,594

Erie, PA – County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper and Erie County Department of Health announce 106 new positive cases of COVID-19 and four new deaths have been reported in Erie County as of 11:59 p.m. on Nov. 23.

The total cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Erie County is 4,594, with 2,870 recovered cases, 1,651 active cases and 73 deaths (reported in NEDSS).

All residents are reminded to wear a mask when near anyone who does not live inside their home; keep a 6-foot distance from others; stay home as much as possible – and definitely when feeling ill; wash hands frequently; and limit activities outside of their homes.
