Erie County reports 146 new positive cases of COVID-19; cumulative case total is 8,551; 14 additional deaths over weekend

Erie, PA – County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper and Erie County Department of Health announce 146 new positive cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Erie County as of 11:59 p.m. on Dec. 13. Over the weekend, 14 additional deaths were reported.

Data from the weekend:

The total cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Erie County is 8,551, with 164 deaths (reported in NEDSS).

As of this morning, there are 144 total hospitalizations and 15 people on ventilators in Erie County.

All residents are reminded to wear a mask that covers their nose and mouth when near anyone who does not live inside their home, keep a 6-foot distance from others, stay home as much as possible – and definitely when feeling ill, wash hands frequently, and limit activities outside of their homes.
