Erie County reports 167 new positive cases of COVID-19; cumulative case total is 10,066; 4 additional deaths over weekend

Erie, PA – County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper and Erie County Department of Health announce 167 new positive cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Erie County as of 11:59 p.m. on Dec. 20. Over the weekend, four additional deaths were reported.

Data from the weekend:

The total cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Erie County is 10,066, with 202 deaths (reported in NEDSS).
