Erie County's General Accounting Office, led by Jim Sparber and Tracey Fugagli, earned the designation for its comprehensive annual financial report for fiscal year ending December 31, 2019.

Erie County's comprehensive annual financial report was judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program, which includes demonstrating a constructive "spirit of full disclosure" to clearly communicate its financial story and motivate potential users and user groups to read the report.
