Erie County reports 76 new positive cases of COVID-19; cumulative case total is 17,426

Erie, Pa. – County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper and Erie County Department of Health announce 76 new positive cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Erie County as of 11:59 p.m. on March 1.

The total cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Erie County since March 2020 is 17,426, with 435 deaths (reported in NEDSS). Currently there are 1,469 active cases in Erie County, and 15,522 cases have recovered and been released from isolation, using the Pennsylvania Department of Health's estimations.
