## **Erie County reports 51 new positive cases of COVID-19; cumulative case total is 17,696**

Erie, PA – County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper and Erie County Department of Health announce 51 new positive cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Erie County as of 11:59 p.m. on March 8.

The total cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Erie County since March 2020 is 17,696, with 444 deaths (reported in NEDSS). Currently there are 1,322 active cases in Erie County, and 15,930 cases have recovered and been released from isolation, using the Pennsylvania Department of Health’s estimations.
