## Erie County reports 19 new positive cases of COVID-19; cumulative case total is 20,492

Erie, PA — County Executive Kathy Dahlkemper and Erie County Department of Health announce 19 new positive cases of COVID-19 have been reported in Erie County as of 11:59 p.m. on May 9.

Data from the weekend:

The total cumulative cases of COVID-19 in Erie County since March 2020 is 20,492, with 462 total deaths, as reported in the National Electronic Disease Surveillance System (NEDSS).

As of this morning, there are 22 total current COVID-19 hospitalizations with four people on ventilators in Erie County.
