Erie County announces changes to Pennsylvania hunting license fees

Erie, PA – The Pennsylvania Game Commission has increased the transaction fees resulting in the new cost of \$6.97 for a Pennsylvania Resident Antlerless Deer License and \$26.97 for a Non-resident Antlerless Deer License. Incorrect payment amounts will result in applications being rejected.

The Erie County Treasurers' Office will begin accepting Pennsylvania Resident Antlerless Deer License applications, by mail only, on Monday, July 12. Applications for nonresidents will be accepted starting Monday, July 19.

The Erie County Treasurers' Office recommends mailing applications no earlier than Friday July 9, to avoid being returned unprocessed. It is important that applicants carefully follow the guidelines established by the Pennsylvania Game Commission, which can be found at www.pgc.pa.gov.

Those applying for an Antlerless Deer License in Wildlife Management Unit 1B should note that the annual allocation for antlerless licenses has been decreased by 9,000 by the Pennsylvania Game Commission and processing delays may decrease the opportunity to obtain a license in this area.

The last day to purchase a Landowner Antlerless License is Friday, July 9. Landowner Antlerless Licenses are only available via the County Treasurers' Office located at the Erie County Court House, 140 W. Sixth Street, Room 109, Erie, Pennsylvania.
