

I have tested positive for COVID-19: What do I need to do?

Isolation keeps people who are infected with the virus away from others, even in their home

I tested positive for COVID-19 and I do have symptoms

I tested positive for COVID-19 but have no symptoms

Isolate at home for 10 days:

Day 1 begins the day AFTER your symptoms started

Isolate at home for 10 days:

Day 1 begins the day AFTER you were tested

Isolation

Do not go to school, work or attend any social activities

Do not allow visitors in your home

You may return to school/work/regular activities when:

At least 10 days have passed since symptoms/testing

AND

You are fever free for 24 hours without medication

AND

Your symptoms are getting better
