

**PA Health Alert Network (PA HAN) 607 replacing 583
Fully Vaccinated Individuals
10.25.2021**

*Status of "Fully Vaccinated" means it is has been 2 weeks or more since the second or only dose of approved vaccine
This guidance does not apply to unvaccinated individuals (follow standard quarantine guidelines)*

I am vaccinated and have symptoms of COVID-19
Isolate and get a PCR test

I am vaccinated and no symptoms but I have a known exposure to someone with COVID-19

Get a PCR test 5-7 days after exposure

Wear a properly fitting face mask in public indoor settings for 14 days or until a negative PCR test

I am vaccinated and no symptoms but I live with someone with COVID-19

Get a PCR test 3-5 days after first exposure

Get a second PCR test 5-7 days after the end of isolation for the person with COVID-19

Wear a mask when in contact with the person with COVID-19 throughout the infected person's isolation period

Wear a mask indoors in public until 14 days after the infected person's isolation period ends or until you receive your final test result

With any positive PCR test you must isolate for 10 days and close contacts will have to quarantine if not vaccinated

When Erie County is in substantial or high transmission, as indicated by the CDC, all individuals regardless of vaccination status should wear a mask in public indoor settings
At this time Erie County is in HIGH TRANSMISSION
