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## Erie County residents encouraged to complete the Community Health Assessment Survey

Erie, PA — All Erie County residents 18 years and older are encouraged to help guide future health programs and services by completing the **Community Health Assessment Survey 2024** organized by the Erie County Department of Health at <https://eriecountypa.gov/healthsurvey>

By asking about people's health experiences and environments, the anonymous survey will be used to better understand the county's health status and concerns. Feedback from the assessment will be collected and analyzed to prepare a Community Health Improvement Plan that will be used to prioritize future health programs and services for the public.

"The health department is encouraging everyone to complete the survey. The more responses we receive, the more information we will have on what Erie County's residents need and want for their health. We will be able to plan and take action accordingly," said Erin Mrenak, director of the health department.

For this assessment, the Erie County Department of Health is working with a committee of community partners, including Allegheny Health Network, Community Health Net, Corry Memorial Hospital, Erie County Dept. of Human Services, LECOM, Hamot Health Foundation, Multi-Cultural Health Evaluation Delivery System (MHEDS) and UPMC Hamot. Results of the assessment will be shared with the public at a later date.

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
